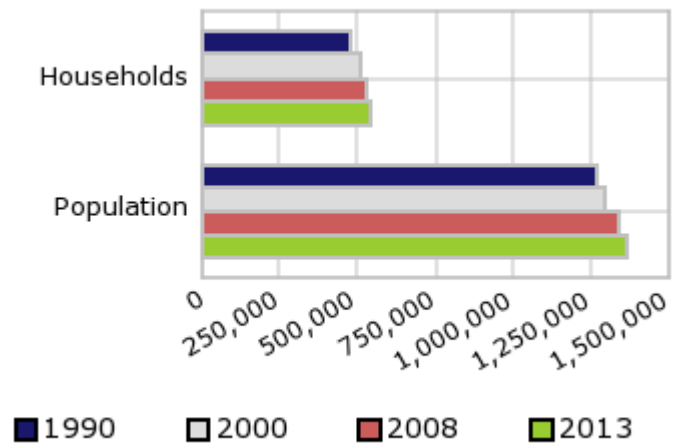
## Executive Summary Report with Charts

### Population Demographics

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **479,269** and changed to **509,892** in 2000, representing a change of **6.4%**. The household count in 2008 was **527,840** and the household projection for 2013 is **538,619**, a change of **2.0%**.

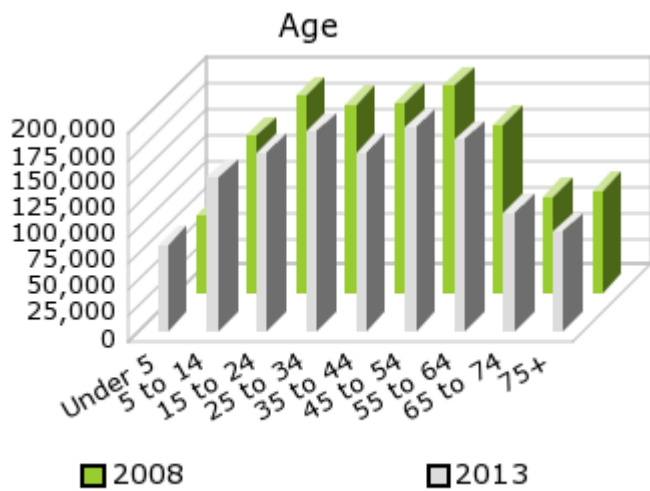
The population in the study area in 1990 was **1,272,075** and in 2000 it was **1,293,353**, roughly a **1.7%** change. The population in 2008 was **1,335,800** and the projection for 2013 is **1,361,551** representing a change of **1.9%**.

### Population by Age



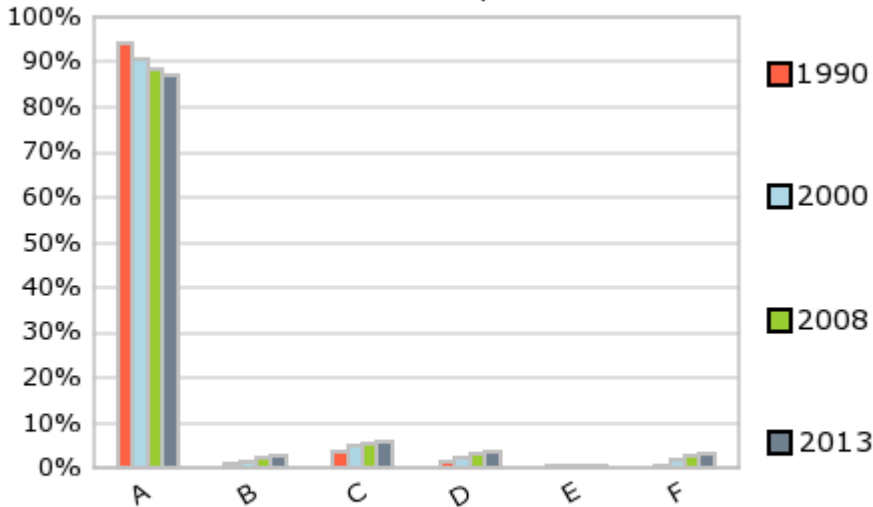
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33.7**, and in 2000, it was **37.6**. The median age in 2008 is **39.1** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39.9** years. In 2008, females represented **50.7%** of the population with a median age of **40.5** and males represented **49.3%** of the population with a median age of **37.6** years. In 2008, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2008, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

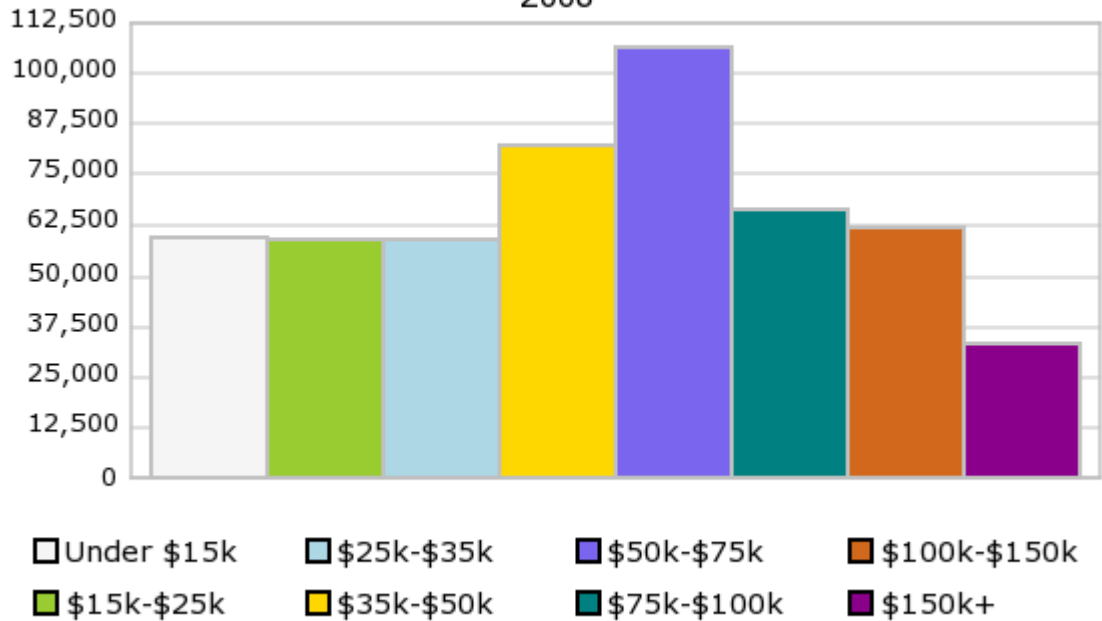
