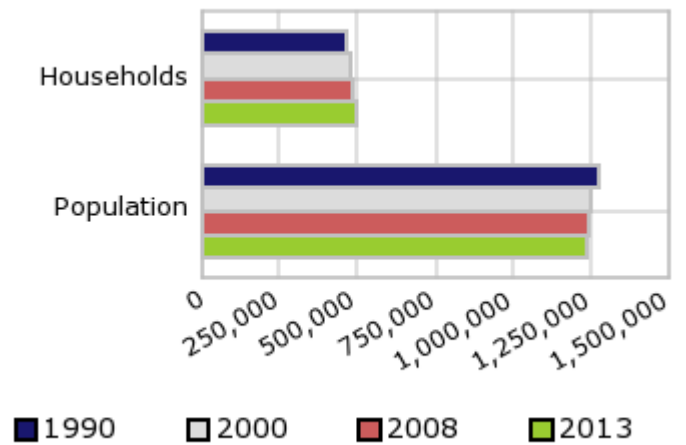
## Executive Summary Report with Charts

### Population Demographics

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **463,715** and changed to **477,097** in 2000, representing a change of **2.9%**. The household count in 2008 was **488,353** and the household projection for 2013 is **495,110**, a change of **1.4%**.

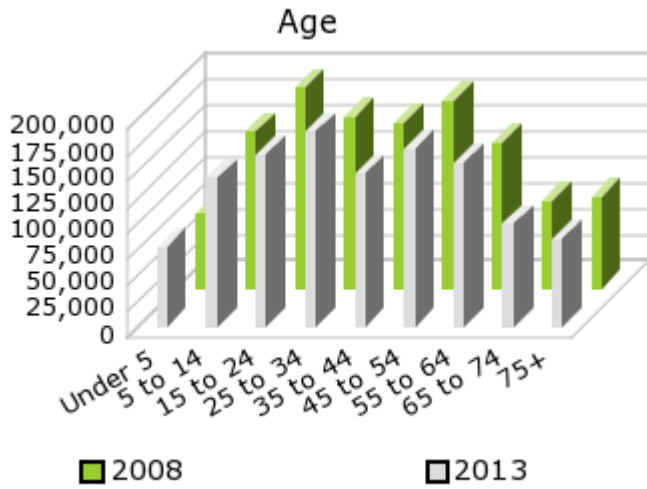
The population in the study area in 1990 was **1,275,170** and in 2000 it was **1,249,262**, roughly a **-2.0%** change. The population in 2008 was **1,243,758** and the projection for 2013 is **1,240,411** representing a change of **-0.3%**.

### Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32.1**, and in 2000, it was **36.2**. The median age in 2008 is **37.4** and it is predicted to change in five years to **37.9** years. In 2008, females represented **51.0%** of the population with a median age of **38.8** and males represented **49.0%** of the population with a median age of **36.1** years. In 2008, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

In 2008, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.

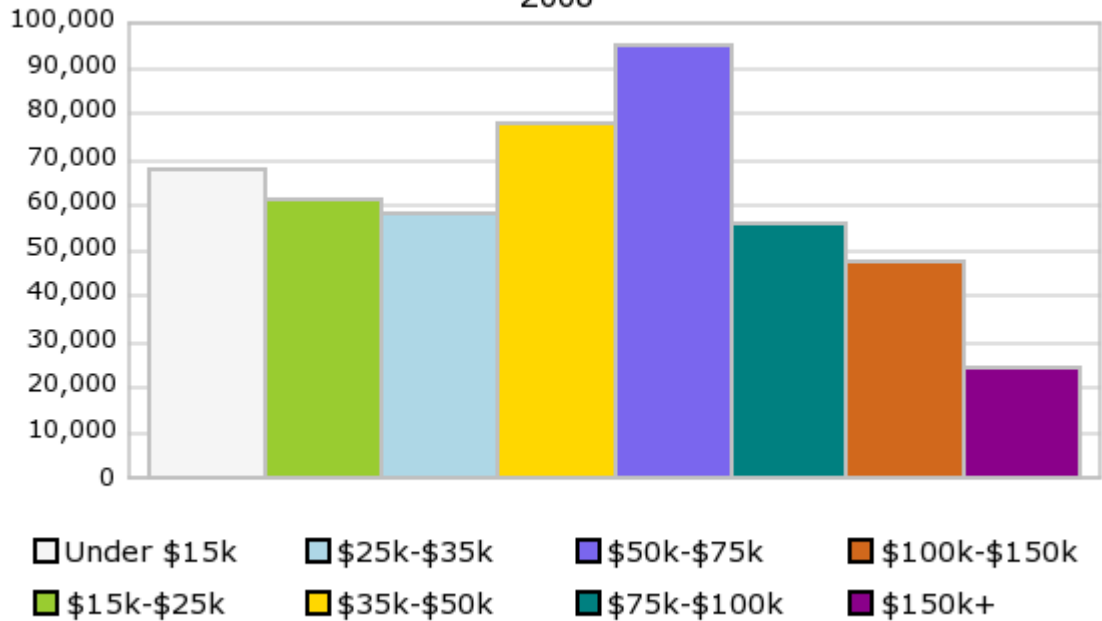
